

# Lomakatsi Restoration Project -- Active Restoration Projects -- 2013/2014

As of Fall 2013, Lomakatsi has approximately 37 over-arching restoration projects in 9 counties. Many of the projects are considered active for a duration between 2010 to 2016. There are 11 crews (including subcontractors) performing various treatments on over 100 specific project sites.

Approximately 5,000 acres are planned for forest and aquatic restoration treatments. Over 6,000 acres of treatments have been accomplished on active projects

Over 10 federal, state and private sources have partnered or contributed nearly \$3.2 million in project funding.
