

# Lomakatsi Restoration Project -- Active Restoration Projects -- 2012/2013

In the fall of 2012, Lomakatsi had approximately 55 overarching restoration projects being worked on in 8 counties. Many of the projects are considered active for a duration between 2010 to 2016. There were 9 crews (including subcontractors) performing treatments on these active projects.

Approximately 4,000 acres were planned for forest restoration treatments. Over 4,000 acres of treatments were accomplished.

10 federal, state and private sources partnered or contributed nearly \$4,000,000 of project funding.
